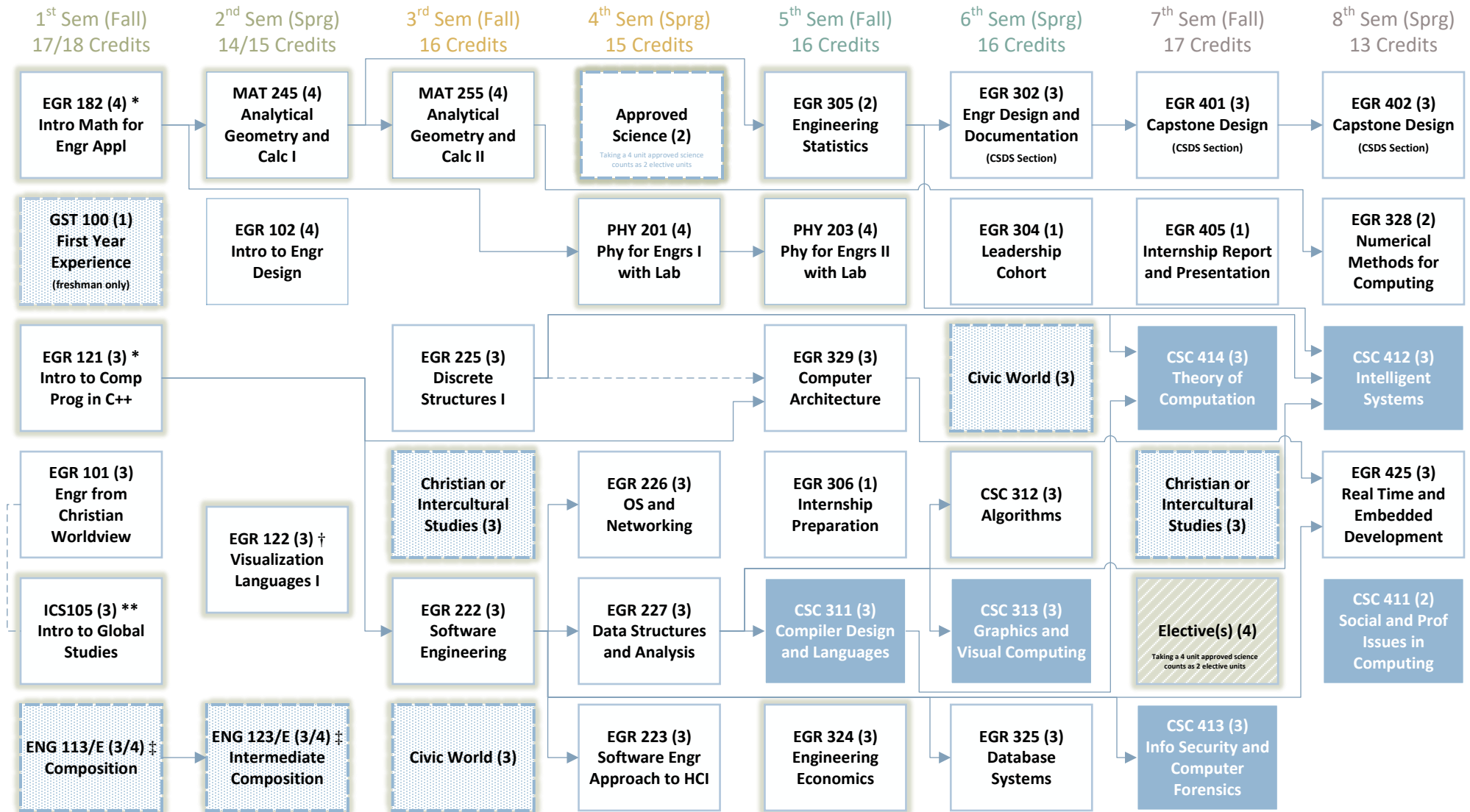


Bachelor of Science in Computer Science Course Flow Chart – 2022/2023 Catalog (124 Units)
